

THE IGANG MARINE STATION (IMS) - SEAFDEC AQUACULTURE DEPARTMENT (SEAFDEC/AQD)

This is located on the southwest portion of Guimaras Island in the Philippines. IMS is composed of four islets and clusters of floating fish cages interconnected by floating foot bridges. The station maintains hundreds of broodstock of various commercially important species that provide eggs for research and production runs. It offers mariculture park demonstration and training facility that serves as a model in promotion of a sustainable mariculture technology for marginal fishers and entrepreneurs who are interested to invest in aquaculture



IGANG BAY MARINE SANCTUARY (IBMS)

The Igang Bay Marine Sanctuary, a locally-managed MPA co-chaired by John B. Lacson Foundation (JBLFMU) and the local chief executive of Nueva Valencia, is one of the best sites to prove that coral rehabilitation works. Several Coral Reef Jackstones, Coral Nursery Units, and Fish Condominiums are deployed in this MPA.





GUIMARAS NATIONAL CROP RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND PRODUCTION SUPPORT CENTER

It is the latest crop center included in the Bureau of Plant Industry family specializing on Research Extension and Production of Mango. The center has 8.87 hectares planted for mango orchard that are used for both research and production and has satellite stations at Pina and Mclain, Buenavista respectively.
