TAKLONG ISLAND NATIONAL MARINE Reserve

This was established in February 1990 through Presidential Proclamation No. 525 dated February 8, 1990 signed by President Corazon Aquino. It forms part of the initial component of the National Integrated Protected Area System (NIPAS) of R.A. 7586 (NIPAS Act 1992). It covers over 1,000 hectares including mangroves, seagrass beds and coral reefs of high biodiversity. It has an aggregate area of 1,143.53 hectares including mangroves, seagrass beds, coral reefs of high biodiversity, various birds, reptiles, and mammals recently recorded.



SUBA MALAWIG

Suba Malawig is a two-kilometer passageway where visitors can appreciate the beauty of mangroves and fished thriving in the area.




PIAGAU ISLET

The members benefit through sharing of income generated from resource user's fee, boat rentals, catering services, and cottage fees.



UPV MARINE BIO STATION

The UPV-MBS is a research and educational facility maintained by the Division of Biological Sciences, College of Arts and Sciences, University of the Philippines Visayas. Since the 1970s, the UPV-MBS at Taklong Island has been the field station for courses in ecology and field biology, plant and animal systematics, and marine resource management. Through the years, the UPV-MBS has evolved as a venue for research, extension and training activities of the UP Visayas.
